• August 1, 2020 (Saturday) - Eid-Al- Adha

The festival celebrates a story about a prophet called Ibrahim (Abraham). Every year, Muslims celebrate Eid al-Adha to remember Ibrahim's loyalty and obedience to Allah above all others. And because of Ibrahim's actions, Eid al-Adha is also known as the Festival of Sacrifice.

• August 3, 2020 (Monday) - Raksha Bandhan

Raksha Bandhan or Rakhi is celebrated on a full moon day in the month of Shravan (August) according to the Hindu calendar because of which this festival is also known as Shravan Purnima. On the occasion of Rakhi, the bond of affection existing between brothers and sisters is reaffirmed.

• August 11, 2020 (Tuesday) - Janmashthami

Krishna Janmashtami, also known simply as Janmashtami or Gokulashtami, is an annual Hindu festival that celebrates the birth of Krishna, the eighth avatar of Vishnu. It is an important festival particularly to the Vaishnavism tradition of Hinduism.

• August 15, 2020 (Saturday) - Independence Day

Independence Day is annually celebrated on 15 August, as a national holiday in India commemorating the nation's independence from the United Kingdom on 15 August 1947, the day when the provisions of the Indian Independence Act 1947, as passed by the UK Parliament, which transferred legislative sovereignty to the Indian .

• August 16, 2020 (Sunday) - Parsi New Year

The Parsi new year, also known as Navroz, is celebrated to mark the beginning of the Iranian calendar. The tradition began some 3000 years ago, and is observed by the Parsi community around the world. The day is also known as Jamshed-i-Nouroz after the Persian King, Jamshed, who introduced the Parsi calendar.

• August 22, 2020 (Saturday) - Ganesh Chathurthi

Ganesh Chaturthi, also known as Vinayaka Chaturthi, is a Hindu festival celebrating the arrival of Lord Ganesh to earth from Kailash Parvat with his mother Goddess Parvati/Gauri. The festival is marked with the installation of Ganesh clay idols privately in homes, or publicly on elaborate pandals.

• August 29, 2020 (Saturday) - Muharram

Muḥarram is the first month of the Islamic calendar. The general meaning of the adjective muharram means "banned, barred, forbidden, illegal, illicit, impermissible, prohibited, unlawful, unauthorised, unpermitted". It is one of the four sacred months of the year during which warfare is forbidden.
